Downtown Denver-

16th Street Mall – *Denver’s own Mile-Long European-Style Mall. Home to the Tabor Center Shops, May D & F Tower, Writer’s Square, Paramount Theater, many historic buildings, shopping, outdoor cafes, microbreweries, and pubs....*

H train to the I-25 and Broadway Station, catch the C train and get off at Union Station. Catch the *Free Mall Ride*.

Invesco Field “*Home to the Denver Broncos, Mammoth, and Colorado Crush*”

H train to the I-25 and Broadway Station, catch the C train and get off at the Invesco Field at Mile High

Coors Field “*Home to the Colorado Rockies*”

H train to the I-25 and Broadway Station, catch the C train and get off at Union Station

Pepsi Center “*Home to the Colorado Avalanche and Denver Nuggets*”

H train to the I-25 and Broadway Station, catch the C train and get off at the Pepsi Center Six Flags station

Six Flags Elitch Gardens “*Thrills From Coaster to Coaster*”

H train to the I-25 and Broadway Station, catch the C train and get off at the Pepsi Center Six Flags station

Convention Center & Performing Arts “*Denver Theater at its Finest*”

H Train and get off at the 13th and California Station
